#### **ELECTRONIC PERMIT-TO-WORK (E-PTW)**

Permit to Work (PTW) is a formal authorisation system used in an organisation to control selected high-risk work activities to ensure safe execution of work onsite. It is widely used in various industries, including the construction industry, and involves at least 3 levels of checks and traditional paperwork.

#### WSH TECHNOLOGY - CONSTRUCTION AND FACILITIES MANAGEMENT

The e-PTW system can record procedures for requesting, reviewing, authorising, documenting, and deconflicting tasks and then visualise the data, allowing managers to quickly verify that workers have the appropriate authorisation to carry out tasks. The e-PTW replaces paper filing of PTW with a centralised digital management system, allowing your organisation to submit, track and monitor PTW applications digitally via mobile apps and browsers.

#### Benefits of e-PTW over traditional paper-based

- 1. Improve coordination and efficiency through real-time notifications.
- 2. Better traceability and accountability of PTW with an audit trail.
- 3. Easy identification of incompatible works.
- 4. Full visibility of PTWs via dashboards.
- 5. Remove need to rewrite documents when PTW needs to be extended or re-issued.

#### **Building façade inspection using:**

The Periodic Facade Inspection (PFI) regime was introduced in 2020 by the Building and Construction Authority (BCA) to enhance the maintenance of building facades for public safety. Benefits of using drones for inspection:

#### Greatly reducing fall from height risks

- 1. Easier and safer to inspect difficult-to-access areas for buildings with complex design
- 2. Less time is taken to do an inspection
- 3. Lower cost of inspection
- 4. Reduce reliance on manpower

#### **NOISE HAZARD:**

Noise is one of the most common physical hazards present in the workplace. Depending on the frequency, amplitude (volume) and duration of exposure, hearing protection may be required. Inadequate hearing protection or prolonged exposure to noise can result in either temporary or permanent hearing loss. Machinery and equipment are the most likely sources of hazardous noise in the workplace.

Noise is a prevalent health hazard in the workplace. Prolonged exposure to excessive noise can cause noise-induced hearing loss or noise-induced deafness (NID). NID refers to a permanent loss of hearing sensitivity which leads to communication difficulties and can have a severe impact on the quality of life. Identification of noise hazards in a workplace enables employers to identify employees who may be exposed to excessive noise so that their exposures can be assessed. Hazard identification should involve the participation of the affected employees and those who understand the works, operations or processes and have knowledge of the work situation.

Noise controls are the first line of defence against excessive noise exposure. The use of these controls should aim to reduce hazardous exposure to the point where the risk of hearing is eliminated or minimized. With the reduction of even a few decibels, the hazard to hearing is reduced, communication is improved, and noise-related annoyance is reduced.

Control or reduction of noise can be carried out:

- · At the source;
- Along the path; and
- At the receiver.

The best approach to control noise is to eliminate or reduce the hazard at its source. If the noise cannot be controlled at its source, attempts should be made to control it along the path to which it travels. As a last resort, the noise control problem may be approached at the receivers or exposed persons.



#### **REDUCE YOUR PLASTIC WASTE:**

The plastics's invasion of the planet is a reality. Just remember that the plastic waste island floating in the Pacific Ocean now measures 1.6 million km2. If we want to save the planet, the time has come for each and every one of us to take action. Plastic has become a constant element in our lives. It's everywhere: product packaging, cosmetic ingredients, textiles, mobile phones, etc. Its omnipresence is such that many would find the mere fact of giving it up a difficult task. Reducing the consumption of plastics therefore requires not only a change in habits, but also a



#### PLASTICS, A GLOBAL PROBLEM:

change of mindset.

Reality is plastics are now a serious problem for the planet is proved by the fact that more governments are proposing measures to reduce their impact on the environment. In July 2021, Europe banned the sale of Single Use Plastic Products (SUPP) such as drinking straws, cutlery or cotton buds. To put the magnitude of the problem into context, let's review some objective data:

- Every year, 500 billion plastic bottles are produced worldwide.
- Plastic in the ocean is already more than 150 million tons of waste.
- By 2050, plastics could contain more than fish.
- Each year around eight million tons of plastic ends up in our seas and oceans.

While on the subject of single-use plastics, which account for half of the plastic we use each year, they have an average useful life of 12 to 15 minutes and yet can take up to 500 years to disappear, according to Life Out Of Plastic (LOOP). The good news is that it is in our hands, as consumers, to turn this situation around. We have the power to make manufacturers change the way they produce. How? by changing the way we consume.

How long does it take for single use plastics to Biodegrade.

- Plastic bottle 500 Years
- Plastic bag 400 Years
- Drinking straw 200 Years
- Toothbrush 500 Years
- Plastic cup 100 Years
- Plastic cutlery 400 Years

#### **USEFUL TIPS FOR REDUCING PLASTICS CONSUMPTION:**

Avoid single-use plastics such as drinking straws

Single-use plastics, such as plates and cutlery made from this material, make our lives easier, but seriously harm the planet. These types of products have viable alternatives.

#### If you go shopping, remember to take a cloth bag:

We go to the supermarket at least once a week to fill up our fridges. If every time we go we use reusable bags the health of our planet will improve. From now on remember to take yours when leaving the house.

#### Buy more bulk food and fewer packaged products:

Disposable containers are inundating supermarkets (polystyrene trays, PET bottles, plastic containers, etc.). But there is an alternative: more and more establishments are offering the possibility to buy in bulk.

#### Replace plastic Tupperware for glass or steel containers:

Tupperware container is part of your day. Suggest you change your routine and opt for glass or stainless-steel containers. Not only will the planet appreciate it, so will your health because some of these plastic containers can release harmful substances.



# Make those around you aware of the importance of reducing the consumption of plastic:

In addition to reducing your consumption of plastic, you manage to get your family, friends and co-workers to do the same by setting an example, the impact of your actions for the good of the planet will increase exponentially.



Pay attention and put your plastic waste in the correct recycling container

Our lifestyle sometimes prevents us from paying attention to details. Therefore,
when it comes to recycling plastic waste it can end up in the wrong container.

Before throwing your waste away, think where each item has to go.

Choose to reuse and give some of the packaging a new purpose

If you have no choice but to buy a plastic bottle or a plastic container at the
supermarket, reuse it instead of throwing it away. A bottle can be filled up as many
times as you like and containers can be used to store other food.
